Your HealthChoice Illinois Plan Choices

All plans have the same **basic** Medicaid services you get now, such as:

- 24/7 nurse line
- Behavioral health services
- Doctor services
- Eye care services
- Hearing services
- Home health care
- Hospice care
- Hospital services
- Lab tests and x-rays
- Medical supplies
- Prescriptions
- Therapy
- Transportation to medically necessary appointments

All plans have extra benefits, such as **Care Coordinators** who will help you find the providers and services you need. Use these charts to compare the **extra** benefits and services each health plan offers.

Important message about health benefits for immigrant seniors and immigrant adults

If you are enrolled in either the **Health Benefits for Immigrant Seniors program** or **Health Benefits for Immigrant Adults program**, your HealthChoice Illinois plan (Medicaid) **will not cover:**

- Long term care facility services
- Home and community based waiver services
- Transplant services other than kidney transplants and inpatient bone marrow transplants

Important message about Medicare benefits

If you receive **Medicare benefits**, Medicare will cover most of the services listed at the top of this page. Your HealthChoice Illinois plan (Medicaid) **will only cover:**

- Your long term care services if you live in a nursing home or supportive living facility
- Your home and community based waiver services (such as the Aging or Physically Disabled waivers)
- Non-emergency transportation and some behavioral health services

Not all extra benefits will apply to you if you receive Medicare benefits. **Extra benefits marked with a star (★) are available to enrollees with Medicare benefits.**

Dental

- Extra dental care for adults including crowns and dentures
- Extra dental services for pregnant women who qualify

Pregnancy and healthy kids

- In our Maternity Matters program, you may qualify for:
 - Up to \$45 a month for diapers for each dependent child age 30 months and younger
 - A free car seat, portable crib, or high chair
 - A free diaper bag
 - In-person doula services for qualifying pregnancies
 - Access to a digital maternal health program with virtual coaching, education, and family planning services
 - Postpartum supplies in a New Mom and Baby Welcome Box
- You may qualify for:
 - Up to \$100 in rewards when you complete a Notification of Pregnancy form and prenatal and postpartum appointments
 - Over \$100 in rewards when you complete well child visits and regular immunizations (shots)

Transportation

- You can get rides to and from pharmacies right after your doctor visits
- You can get rides to and from medical equipment providers
- New mothers can get rides to and from Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) food assistance sites for 30 days after their baby's birth
- You can book rides instantly through a mobile app with real-time ride statuses
- You can use Uber and Lyft for qualifying rides

Vision

- You can get \$100 toward a pair of eyeglass frames, choose a free pair of eyeglass frames from the MARCH frame kit, or get \$80 toward contact lenses every two years

Wellness

- You may qualify for:
 - A free Smartphone through Lifeline cell services
 - A free gym membership and WW® (formerly Weight Watchers®) for members ages 13 and older
 - Free meal delivery programs with personalized nutrition and dietician services
 - Access to MyOwnDoctor telehealth services for mental and physical well-being with physicians who look and sound like you
 - Access to Moodfit and PvxHealth 24/7 behavioral health digital apps to help reduce stress, manage and track moods, and address loneliness for members ages 12 and up
- You can get \$25 a month to spend on OTC health care products
- You can get Aetna® Better Care Rewards when you complete certain preventive services, such as yearly wellness visits

- Two teeth cleanings per year for adults
- Extra dental care for adults

Pregnancy and healthy kids

- In our Special Beginnings program, you may qualify for:
 - A free car seat or portable crib by keeping one prenatal appointment during the first trimester of pregnancy
 - Two free packages of diapers by keeping postpartum appointments
 - A gift card by keeping at least six well child appointments

- You can get rides to and from:
 - Pharmacies
 - Provider appointments
 - Events sponsored by Blue Cross Community ★

Vision

- You can get \$40 toward a pair of upgraded eyeglass frames every two years

Wellness

- You may qualify for:
 - Gift cards when you complete certain preventive services in the Healthy Incentives program, such as yearly breast cancer screenings ★
 - A free cell phone to call your doctor, care coordinator or 9-1-1 emergency services ★
- You can get \$25 in OTC items by mail every three months ★
- You can get a free membership to Blue365, a program that offers health and wellness discounts ★
- You can get help to stop smoking ★

- Extra dental care for adults including exams and cleanings
- Extra dental services for pregnant women who qualify

Pregnancy and healthy kids

- In our Brighter Beginnings Program, you may qualify for:
 - Monthly diaper coupon by having up-to-date regular immunizations (shots)
 - Up to \$415 in rewards cards by keeping prenatal, postpartum and well child appointments
 - A Sleep Safe Kit with a portable crib by keeping prenatal appointments
 - A free car seat or booster seat
 - A free electric breast pump once a year

Transportation

- You can get rides to and from:
 - All covered services
 - Pharmacies right after your doctor visits
 - Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) food assistance sites

Vision

- You may qualify for free LASIK eye surgery
- Adults can get \$100 toward eyeglasses or contact lenses every two years
- Children can get \$100 toward eyeglasses or contact lenses every 12 months

Wellness

- You may qualify for rewards on your CountyCare Visa Rewards Card when you complete certain preventive services such as:
 - Yearly health risk screening ★
 - Yearly colorectal screening for members ages 45 to 75
 - Yearly cervical cancer screening for members ages 21 to 64
 - Yearly primary care provider visit
 - Yearly mammogram for members ages 45 to 74
 - Yearly flu shot for members 6 months old and older
- You can get free WW[®] (formerly Weight Watchers[®]) vouchers ★
- You can get free meetings with a personal nutrition coach and grocery money when you complete appointments

Dental

- Up to two routine preventive exams and one x-ray per calendar year for members of all ages

Pregnancy and healthy kids

- You may qualify for:
 - Up to \$50 in gift cards when you complete a Notification of Pregnancy form
 - Up to \$100 in gift cards by keeping well child appointments and getting regular immunizations (shots)
 - A free stroller, playpen/cribette, car seat or high chair by keeping prenatal appointments
 - Up to \$50 by keeping prenatal and postpartum appointments

Transportation

- You can get rides to and from:
 - Pharmacies
 - Medical equipment providers
 - Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) food assistance sites

Vision

- No limit on eyeglasses for members younger than age 21
- Members age 21 and older can get one pair of eyeglasses every two years

Wellness

- You may qualify for:
 - Gift cards when you complete certain preventive services in the Healthy Rewards program
 - Nutrition services, counseling, diabetes education classes and programs to help you manage your weight, including a free weight management program
- You can get help to stop smoking
- Members with Medicare can get \$10 in OTC items by mail each month 🌟
